La licence FSP vise à offrir aux fournisseurs de services aux institutions financières un régime de contrôle favorable s'ils souhaitent établir une présence commerciale et opérer à Maurice ou à partir de l'île.

Cette licence particulière est celle d'un courtier en valeurs mobilières qui s'est constitué en société en 2020.

La licence est déjà assurée pour un an et a obtenu l'approbation préalable pour la mise en place de Virtual Pay.

L'entreprise proposée détient deux types de licences :

- 1. La licence de négociant, en vertu de la loi sur les valeurs mobilières de 2005.
- 2. Licence de titres, en vertu des règles d'octroi de licences 2007.
- 3. Licence de services financiers, en vertu des Consolidated Licensing and Fees Rules 2008
- 4. Global Business License (GBL), en vertu de la loi sur les services financiers.
